Kuhr and Richard Harwood of The Harwood Institute are partners on Covering Community, a project to develop a community coverage handbook and Web site for professional and citizen journalists, journalism students and professors. The project is funded by the John S. and James L. Knight Foundation. The Web site, www.coveringcommunities.org, will be available to the public in 2007. Kuhr is on the Academic Advisory Board for the Dole Institute of Politics at KU; and serves on New Voices Advisory Board, for J-Lab: The Institute for Interactive Journalism. She has served on the Associated Press Managing Editors board of directors. She is head of the Community Journalism Interest Group with the Association for Education in Journalism and Mass Communication for 2006-07. Kuhr has worked for *The Hartford Courant* in Hartford, Conn., and the *Great Falls (Mont.) Tribune*.
